70th International Meeting 22nd – 28th July 2018 PARIS



The Art and Science of Medicine

During this three-day meeting, open to all in the caring professions interested in the role of relationship in care, our speakers will be talking about topics to do with the tension between science and how we care for patients in practice.

For science is universal whereas practical care is specific to the individual. The topics will include the role of evidence based medicine, of placebo, the beliefs of the doctor and the future of medicine, spirituality and medical research.

In our small groups, we will have the chance to discuss together current scientific thought, how we practice care, what we know, but also how we live each therapeutic relationship, since no patient or carer are ever the same.

This is an international conference for those who seek to offer care to the whole person; a rare opportunity for doctors, other healthcare professionals, students and their spouses to meet together.
